This is a one-day workshop, taught by industry experts and the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA). Instructors will train pesticide handlers in safe pesticide handling techniques. WSDA instructors provide practical, hands-on training in pesticide mixing and loading, personal protective equipment (PPE) use, respirator use and maintenance and PPE decontamination. The workshop meets the training requirements of the EPA's Agricultural Worker Protection Standard (WPS).

- Upon completion of the workshop, participants will receive a WPS Handler Training Verification Card or, if licensed, six recertification credits.
- Participants need a warm coat and other appropriate attire for outside class work.
- The workshop is taught in Spanish. English language class is available if at least 15 registrants request it by **February 7**
- Minimum number for class to proceed is 24 with a max capacity of 50.
- Deadline to register is Wednesday, February 15. **No refunds issued after February 7.**
- Morning coffee, pastries, and lunch are included in registration fee.
